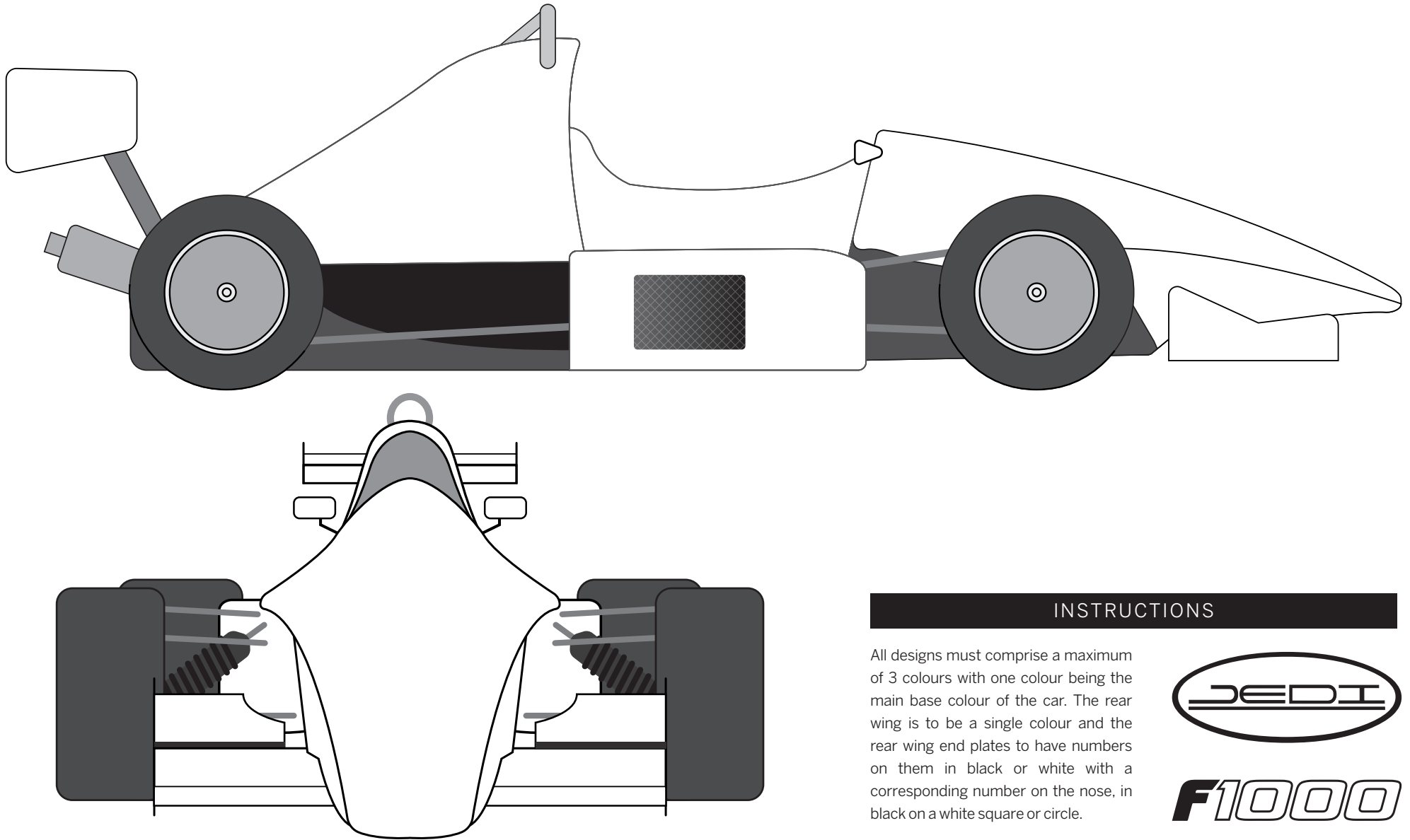

  2. The competition is open to children age 16 and under. Parent/Guardian must consent by signing the entry form.

  4. Entries must be submitted in the format specified. Proof of posting is not proof of our receipt of your entry and Jedi Racing Cars Ltd accepts no responsibility for lost, delayed or damaged entries or entries that are not received for any reason. Only those entries carrying correct postage will be accepted
  5. Entry to the competition is free, however, all materials for the creation and submission of the design must be provided by the individual.
  6. All designs must be the original idea of the entrant and not infringe on anyone else's copyright. By entering the competition the entrant warrants that all information they submit is correct and not obscene or offensive or otherwise in breach of any third party rights and Jedi Racing Cars reserves the right to verify the eligibility of entrants.
  7. All designs must comprise a maximum of 3 colours with one colour being the main base colour of the car. All entries which are based on more than 3 colours will not be judged. The rear wing is to be left blank/single colour and the rear wing end plates to have numbers on them in black or white with a corresponding number on the nose, in black/white in a square or circle.
  8. Entries must be received no later than Friday 15th February 2019
  9. Please ensure your name, age, address and contact telephone number are marked clearly and legibly on the back of your design. We are only able to accept one submission per person
  10. Artwork cannot be returned.
  11. The winner of the competition shall be decided by a panel of judges led by Frazer Corbyn, Jedi Racing Cars. The panel will be looking for creativity, originality and an imaginative response to the theme within the 3 colour parameter.
  12. The design of the F1000 Junior Development Programme Jedi Test Car will be based on the winning entry. For practical and regulatory reasons, it may not be an exact copy.
  13. By entering the competition, individuals give their consent to Jedi Racing Cars Ltd and F1000 UK Ltd, operating as the F1000 Championship, to use their work, free of charge, in any publicity and/or promotional activities. They hereby assign all intellectual property rights (if any) and waive all moral rights in their entry to Jedi Racing Cars Ltd. In particular, if an entrant is a winner of the competition, the entrant consents to their winning work being used as the basis for the F1000 Junior Development Programme Jedi Test Car design, their name being posted on the website or social media. Winners must agree that they may be asked to be photographed and interviewed for publicity purposes.

  15. The winner will be announced on 9th March 2019. The Winner will be advised beforehand.
